

Our Mission, Objective and Purpose.

MISSION:

The UMSO shall carry the message of recovery to addicts who still suffer from addiction, and support the efforts of the Narcotics Anonymous Fellowship of the Minnesota Region to provide opportunity for recovery from addiction.

OBJECTIVE:

The UMSO shall provide administrative, organizational and logistical services to the Minnesota Regional Service Conference (MNRSC) of Narcotics Anonymous and the at-large Fellowship of Narcotics Anonymous, and shall perform in other capacities as directed by the MNRSC.

PURPOSES:

- 1.) To provide service to individual addicts and groups of addicts seeking recovery from addiction, and to the chemical dependency treatment system, and legal and judicial systems within the Minnesota Region; and to assist the general public in understanding addiction and the Narcotics Anonymous (NA) program. These services may include direct and indirect communications with addicts, organizations, agencies, governments and the public at large.
- 2.) To publish NA meeting lists and distribute NA Fellowship and Conference-approved periodicals, materials and literature, provided by the World Service Office, Inc, to the Narcotics Anonymous Fellowship.
- 3.) To hold, as a charitable trust, any income produced by the activities specified in this Article or other activities determined by the Board of Directors; and to manage the trust in a manner that enables the activities to be conducted within the spirit of the *Twelve Steps* and *Twelve Traditions of Narcotics Anonymous* and the *Twelve Concepts of NA Service*.
